	How to sort properly.	Does not go in the recycling bin.
Packaging made of	<p>Plastic and metal</p>  <p>Plastic film, drinks packaging, coffee packaging, vacuum packs, frozen food packaging, empty and rinsed out containers for cleaning products and cosmetics. Composite materials such as tablet packages, polystyrene, food cans, drinks caps, aluminium foil, empty aerosol cans (free of compressed gas), paint cans and varnish tins – spatula-cleaned and drip-free only</p>	<p>No drinks cans or bottles bearing deposit logos. Everything which is not packaging: e.g. broken toys, toothbrushes, clothes hangers, tights, video cassettes, aerosol cans and gas cartridges, etc. with non-recyclable contents, pots and pans, household scrap (→ Recycling centre)</p>  <p>Please return PET bottles and drinks cans to the shop.</p>
	<p>Paper and cardboard</p>  <p>Paper: newspapers, magazines, brochures, notebooks, books, catalogues, advertising leaflets, envelopes with windows, uncoated clean paper; Cardboard: cartons, corrugated cardboard, cardboard boxes, kraft paper bags → please fold</p>	<p>Carbon paper, cellophane, wallpaper, paper tissues, frozen food packaging (coated)</p> 
	<p>Coloured and clear glass</p>  <p>Empty glass containers (bottles, perfume bottles, foodstuff jars, cosmetics bottles, glass phials, etc.) → No bottles with refundable deposits please – they can be refilled. Please sort clear and coloured glass carefully and remove lids.</p>	<p>Lids, caps, glassware, drinking glasses, light bulbs, porcelain, earthenware bottles, ceramics, (→ Non-recyclable waste), window panes, mirror glass and wired glass (→ Recycling centre)</p> 
	<p>Organic waste</p>  <p>Fruit and vegetable waste, spoiled foodstuffs and food scraps, egg shells, coffee grounds and filters, used tea leaves and tea bags, cut flowers, wood shavings</p>	<p>Cat litter, vacuum bags, disposable nappies, cigarette ends, problematic waste, non-recyclable waste, ash from coal-burning stoves, packaging</p> 
	<p>Non-recyclable waste</p>  <p>Waste which cannot be reprocessed in any form: cigarette ends, clothes hangers, CDs, music and video cassettes, toothbrushes, broken porcelain and ceramic, ash from coal-burning stoves, vacuum bags, tights, disposable nappies, hygiene items, broken toys</p>	<p>Waste which can be reprocessed! This includes waste materials such as clothes and shoes that can still be worn, old electrical equipment, all packaging (glass, metal, cardboard, plastic) and organic waste, e-cigarettes</p> 
	<p>Bulky waste</p>  <p>Household waste which does not fit in the non-recyclable waste bin due to its size or shape, broken furniture, carpets, sports equipment, skis, pushchairs → intact furniture and objects: ask our Environment and Waste Advice Service.</p>	<p>Non-recyclable waste, building rubble, problematic waste, paints and varnishes, tyres</p> 
	<p>Old electrical devices</p>  <p>Washing machines and dishwashers, freezers, fridges (without contents), televisions, computers and displays, toasters, mobile phones, hairdryers, electric shavers, radios, energy-saving lamps, fluorescent lamps, device batteries, lithium ion batteries, e-cigarettes</p>	<p>Toy railways (tracks, carriages), toy car racing tracks, CDs, MCs, video cassettes, printer cartridges, cable rolls, greetings cards (with sound)</p> 
	<p>Problematic Waste</p>  <p>Used oil, paints and varnishes, medicines, solvents, acids, alkaline solutions, cellulose thinners, batteries, cosmetics, mercury, disinfectants, photographic chemicals, used cooking oil and fat (oil collection)</p>	<p>Completely empty and drip-free receptacles of paint, varnish and cleaning agents, etc. are counted as packaging and must be disposed of appropriately.</p>

Roßau Recycling Centre

A central waste disposal facility is available for all citizens of Innsbruck.

Free of charge: plastic and metal, paper, cardboard and wooden packaging, clear and coloured glass, packaging polystyrene, household scrap, old electrical devices, frameless panes of glass (e.g. mirrors), problematic materials, used cooking oil ("Öli" containers), textiles and shoes, bulky waste, bags (schoolbags and handbags), small quantities of green waste (<0.5 m³)

Fee required: building site waste (e.g. windows, doors, drywall panels, rubble and demolition materials, commercial waste (e.g. manufacturing waste), wood, tyres

- Free disposal of trees, shrubs and grass cuttings for Innsbruck residents (no charge for quantities of up to 1,000 kg/year)
- Quantities above this amount can be disposed of for a fee
